What is the best time to see the Great Migration?

The Great Migration can be witnessed year-round as the herds move in a circular pattern. However, the best time to see the river crossings is generally between July and October.

What type of vehicle is used for the safari?

We use 4x4 safari vehicles that are specifically designed for game viewing. They provide comfort and excellent visibility, ensuring you have a great experience.

Are the safaris private or group tours?
