What should I pack for the safari?

Pack light, breathable clothing for warm days and a jacket for cooler evenings. Don't forget sunscreen, a hat, and comfortable shoes. Binoculars and a camera are essential for wildlife viewing.

Is the safari suitable for children?

Are vaccinations required for travel?

Consult your doctor for the most current advice on vaccinations. Generally, vaccinations for yellow fever and hepatitis are recommended, along with malaria prophylaxis.

What is the best time of year to visit?

The dry season is ideal for wildlife viewing, while the green season offers lush landscapes and fewer tourists. Each season provides a unique experience, so it depends on your preferences.

How safe is the safari experience?

Safety is our top priority. Our guides are trained to handle various situations, and all vehicles are well-maintained. We also provide emergency evacuation insurance for peace of mind.

Can dietary restrictions be accommodated?

What types of vehicles are used?
