Lemosho Gate to Mti Mkubwa Camp | Rainforest Trekking

Day 2

Meals: Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner | Accommodation: Luxury Mountain Camp - Mti Mkubwa

After breakfast, you will drive to the Lemosho Gate for official registration before beginning your climb. The journey starts in the lush rainforest zone, where trails are surrounded by giant trees, exotic birds, and monkeys. You will trek through this vibrant ecosystem, enjoying the unique mountain vegetation before arriving at Mti Mkubwa Camp. You will spend your first night on the mountain surrounded by the serene tropical forest wilderness.

Mti Mkubwa Camp to Shira Camp 1 | Moorland Landscapes

Day 3

Today's trek leaves the dense rainforest behind as you enter the scenic moorland zone. You will be greeted by breathtaking panoramic views across the Shira Plateau and Kilimanjaro's dramatic volcanic landscape. As you ascend toward Shira Camp 1, you will encounter unique flora like giant groundsels and enjoy the open wilderness. The day concludes with a spectacular sunset over the plateau, offering incredible photography opportunities.

Shira Camp to Lava Tower & Barranco Camp | Acclimatization

Day 4

Meals: Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner | Accommodation: Luxury Mountain Camp - Barranco Camp

This is a critical day for your success, following the legendary climb high, sleep low strategy. You will trek upward to the imposing Lava Tower at 4,630m for lunch and acclimatization before descending into the spectacular Barranco Valley. This route provides dramatic volcanic scenery and your first close-up views of the mountain's glaciers and giant alpine vegetation. Sleeping at a

lower altitude after reaching the tower significantly aids your body's adaptation to the height.

Day 5

Meals: Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner | Accommodation: Luxury Mountain Camp - Karanga Camp

The day begins with the thrilling climb of the famous Barranco Wall. While it may look intimidating, it is one of the most exciting and scenic sections of the trek, offering breathtaking views of the surrounding peaks. Once at the top, you will continue across alpine valleys and rocky landscapes toward Karanga Camp. This shorter day is designed for further acclimatization and rest before the final push to the high camp.

Karanga Camp to Barafu Camp | Summit Preparation

Day 6

Meals: Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner | Accommodation: Luxury Mountain Camp - Barafu Camp

You will ascend gradually toward Barafu Camp, your final base before the summit attempt. The landscape here is a true alpine desert, offering magnificent views of Mawenzi Peak and the surrounding glaciers. Upon arrival, you will receive a final, detailed summit briefing from your guides. You will have an early dinner and rest as much as possible before being woken at midnight to begin the final ascent to Uhuru Peak.

Summit Day | Uhuru Peak to Millennium Camp

Day 7

Meals: Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner | Accommodation: Millennium Camp

Shortly after midnight, you will begin the final ascent under the stars toward Stella Point on the crater rim. From there, you will continue to Uhuru Peak, the highest point in Africa. After celebrating your achievement and witnessing a world-class sunrise above the clouds, you will begin your descent. You will stop briefly at Barafu Camp for rest before continuing down to Millennium Camp for a well-earned night of recovery.

Day 8**Millennium Camp to Mweka Gate | Return to Arusha**

This is a day of celebration as you complete your descent and receive your official Mount Kilimanjaro summit certificates. After a farewell to your mountain crew, you will be transferred back to the luxury lodge in Arusha for a hot shower and a celebratory evening.

Day 9**Departure Day | End of the Glory Trek**

After a final breakfast at the lodge, you will be transferred to Kilimanjaro International Airport for your departure flight. For those not ready to leave Tanzania, this is the perfect time to begin an optional Serengeti safari or a relaxing Zanzibar beach extension. Your epic journey to the roof of Africa concludes with lifelong memories of your achievement.

Frequently Asked Questions

Why is the Lemosho Route considered the best for summit success?

The Lemosho Route is longer than most routes, with 8 days on the mountain, which allows for a more gradual acclimatization process. By spending more time at intermediate altitudes and using the climb high, sleep low strategy, your body has a better chance of adapting to the thinning air compared to shorter routes.

What safety measures are in place during the climb?

Guides are trained in high-altitude safety and perform daily health checks using pulse oximeters to monitor oxygen saturation and heart rate. The crew also carries emergency oxygen cylinders and follows mountain safety protocols throughout the expedition.

Do I need professional mountaineering experience?

No, Kilimanjaro is a trekking mountain, so no technical climbing gear like ropes or ice axes is required. However, it is physically demanding, so a solid training plan with hiking and cardio for 2u20133 months before arrival is recommended.

What kind of food is served on the mountain?

Mountain cooks prepare fresh, high-energy meals designed for high-altitude nutrition. Breakfast may include porridge, eggs, and fruit, while lunch and dinner usually include soups, carbohydrates, and proteins. Dietary restrictions can be accommodated with advance notice.

How much weight will I need to carry myself?

You will only carry a daypack with essentials for the day, such as water, snacks, camera, and rain gear, usually weighing around 5u20137kg. Porters carry the rest of your luggage, camping equipment, and food supplies to the next camp.
