Day 2

After breakfast, you will fly or drive into the heart of the Serengeti National Park, where the savannah seems to stretch infinitely to the horizon. As the sun begins to set, painting the sky in shades of orange and purple, you will head to your luxury tented camp to relax by the campfire and enjoy a gourmet dinner under the stars.

Day 3

Meals: Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner | Accommodation: Luxury Safari Camp

Today begins with a pre-dawn wake-up call for the ultimate highlight: a sunrise hot air balloon flight. You will lift off as the first light hits the plains, gliding silently over herds of wildebeest, zebras, and giraffes. After an hour of breathtaking aerial views and photography, you will land in the wilderness for a traditional champagne bush breakfast. The rest of the day is spent on a morning game drive to track predators like lions and cheetahs, followed by an evening of relaxation back at your luxury camp.

Day 4

Meals: Breakfast, Lunch

On your final morning, you will enjoy a last game drive, taking advantage of the early hours when predators are most active. This is the perfect time to capture final wildlife photographs and track any elusive species you may have missed. After a farewell lunch in the bush and a final safari debrief with your guide, you will be transferred to the airstrip for your return flight to Arusha or your connecting flight, concluding your extraordinary sky-and-land adventure.

Frequently Asked Questions

What time does the balloon safari start, and how long is the flight?

The adventure begins very early, typically with a 5:00 AM pickup from your camp to reach the launch site before dawn. The flight itself lasts approximately one hour, depending on weather conditions, followed by the bush breakfast and a drive back to camp.

Is the balloon flight safe for someone afraid of heights?

Most guests find the experience surprisingly serene rather than scary. Because the balloon moves with the wind, there is no swaying motion or wind whistle. The basket is sturdy and deep, providing a very secure feeling as you glide smoothly over the plains.

What should I wear for the morning balloon flight?

It is quite chilly on the Serengeti plains before sunrise, so we recommend dressing in layers. A warm jacket, trousers, and closed-toed shoes are essential. Once the sun comes up and the burners are firing, it will warm up quickly, and you can shed your outer layers.

Are there age or physical restrictions for the balloon safari?

Children must typically be at least 7 years old and tall enough to see over the edge of the basket, approximately 1.2 meters. Participants should be able to climb in and out of the basket and stand for the duration of the hour-long flight.

What happens if the weather is too poor for the balloon to fly?

Safety is the absolute priority. If the pilot determines that weather conditions such as high winds or heavy rain make it unsafe to fly, the flight will be cancelled. In rare cases, the flight can be rescheduled for the following morning or the balloon portion of the package can be refunded.
